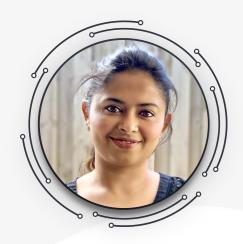

What is TCSI?

- TCSI stands for Tertiary Collection of Student Information
- 2. A new solution for training providers to supply student data to the government for VSL and HE
- 3. TCSI replaces HEPCAT
- 4. Continuous streaming of data to TCSI via API and/or manual uploads
 - Monitor streaming







TCSI Implementation Phases

- Add/Modify fields in Wisenet to meet
 TCSI data collection requirements *Done*
- 2. Connected App for PRODA (used to connect to TCSI) *Done*
- Build TCSI integration to streamline the reporting of student data to TCSI - Done
- 4. Transition customers to TCSI *IN PROGRESS*







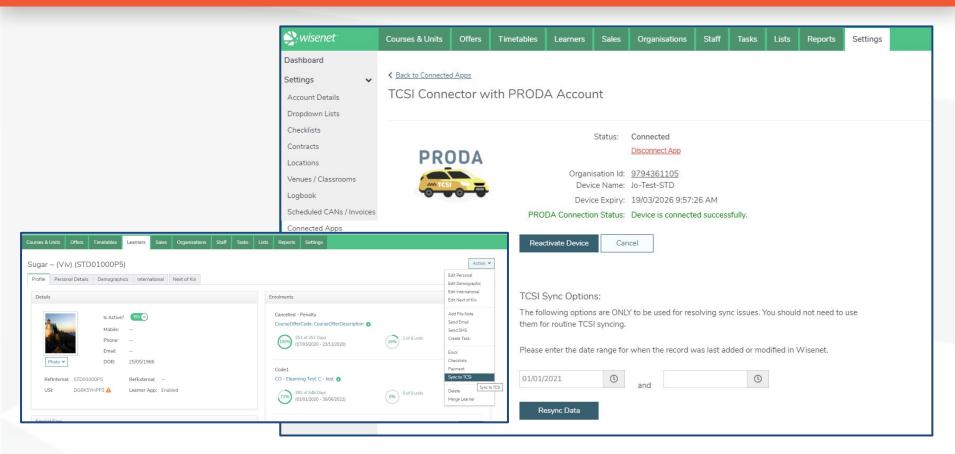
How TCSI Integration works?

- Wisenet has designed the TCSI data sync to automatically syncs your VSL and HE data to TCSI
- The sync process occurs nightly and detects any relevant TCSI data changes that occurred during the past 24 hours.
- There are also 2 manual data sync options for TCSI:
 - Sync a specific Learner record including TCSI Enrolments
 - Used when a change is made to a Learner or their Enrolment and needs immediate syncing
 - Resync any records changed within a desired date period
 - When many changes have been made or PRODA was disconnected





Data Sync Options







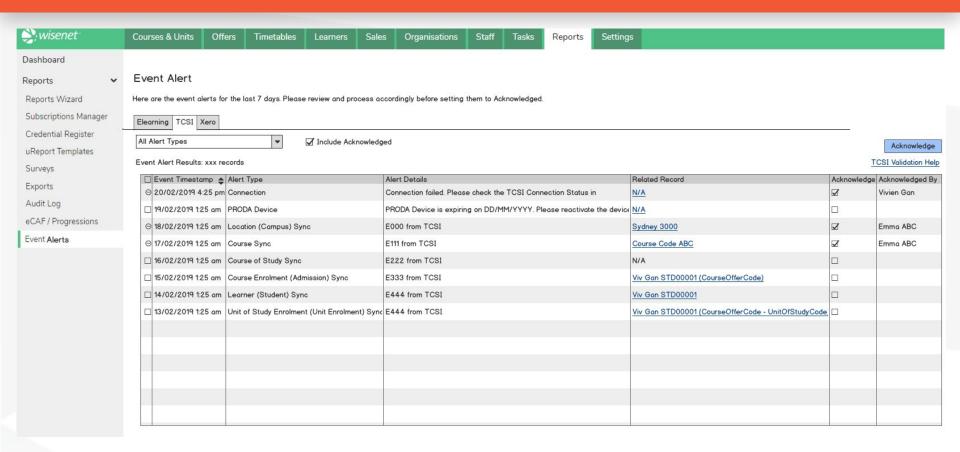
What do I need to do for TCSI?

- Ensure that all TCSI records have the correct data collected
- The sync process will detect if there are data issues
- These issues will be raised in a *NEW* Event Alerts feature
- This will outline what issue prevented the record from syncing
- You will need to resolve the data issue and let the data resync

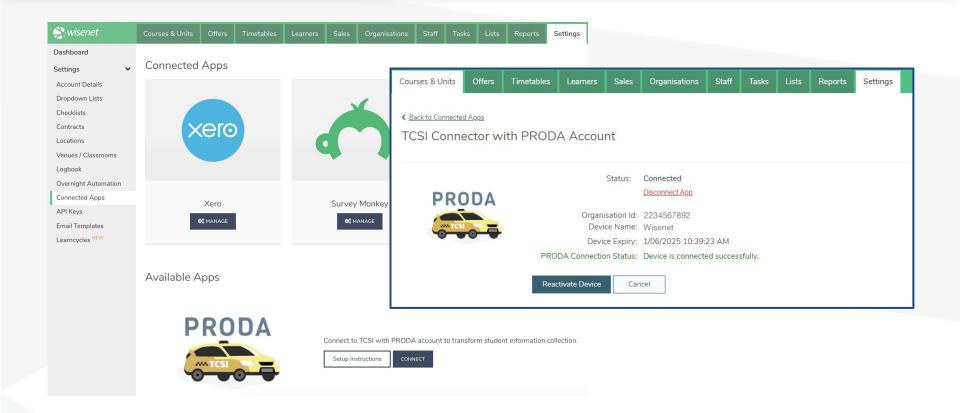

Phase 1: Pre-GoLive

In Wisenet:

- Advise Wisenet who your Key Contact is for the TCSI Migration
- 2. Ensure that PRODA is Connected
- 3. Resolve all validations in report 0948

- 5. Request a Data Extract from TCSI

In TCSI:

Phase 2: GoLive

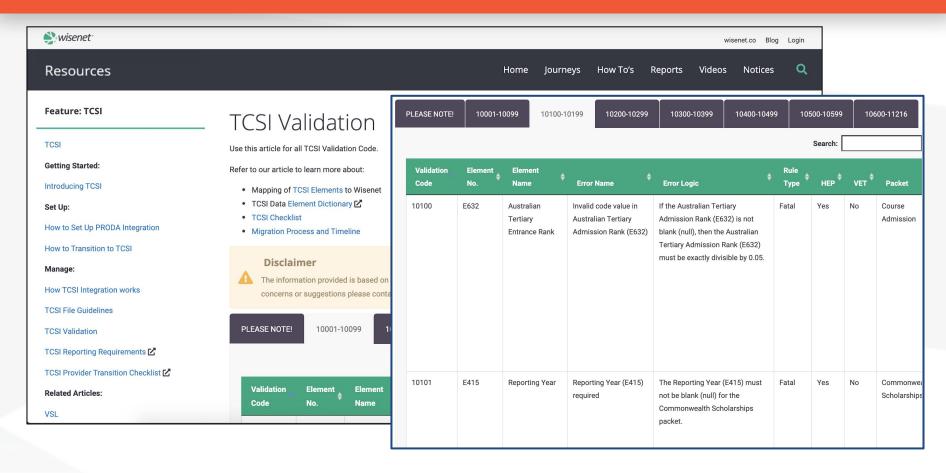
Once the TCSI account is enabled for GoLive, Wisenet will be able to initiate TCSI data streaming.

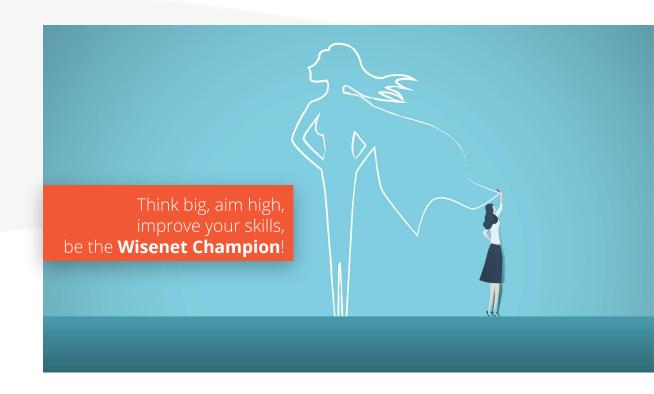
